STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Must be considered to be a member of a racial or ethnic minority group.

Must reside in the assigned county or live within a reasonable commuting distance. Must have own transportation.

Must be present at the Orientation.

Must complete the entire internship, Full-time hours at 40/week. Hours must be flexible

Must submit a written summary report at the end of the internship.

Must be present and give an oral presentation at the Internship Presentation Day (usually in July at the end of the internship).





INTERN ELIGIBILITY

Must be enrolled in a college of agriculture, family and consumer sciences, or a closely related major.

Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher (on a 4.0 system).

Should have completed approximately 50 percent of required course work for the Bachelor's degree.

Preference given to students presently enrolled at Tennessee State University.

Preference given to students with previous experience in Extension programs or those considering Extension for employment.
