As interest in gardening appears to remain strong locally, the Rutherford Co. Extension office has an event scheduled June 1st that may appeal to lawn and garden enthusiasts. The Garden Extravaganza is scheduled for Saturday, June 1st from 10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. at Lane Agri-Park located at 315 John R. Rice Blvd in Murfreesboro. Just show up that day and stop by the outdoor pavilion adjacent to the butterfly and vegetable garden demonstration area to check-in and pick up a schedule and map of the different garden and demonstration areas.
