4-H ARCHERY

Open to 4th - 12th Graders

Beginner Archery:

All participants new to 4-H archery must sign up for a beginner archery session. This course will introduce participants to archery equipment, range safety, eye dominance, target scoring, etc. There is a limit of 20 participants for each class. If the class does not show up on the dropdown in the Ag Store, it is full. The fee for beginner archery is \$25 for a session that includes 6 dates.
