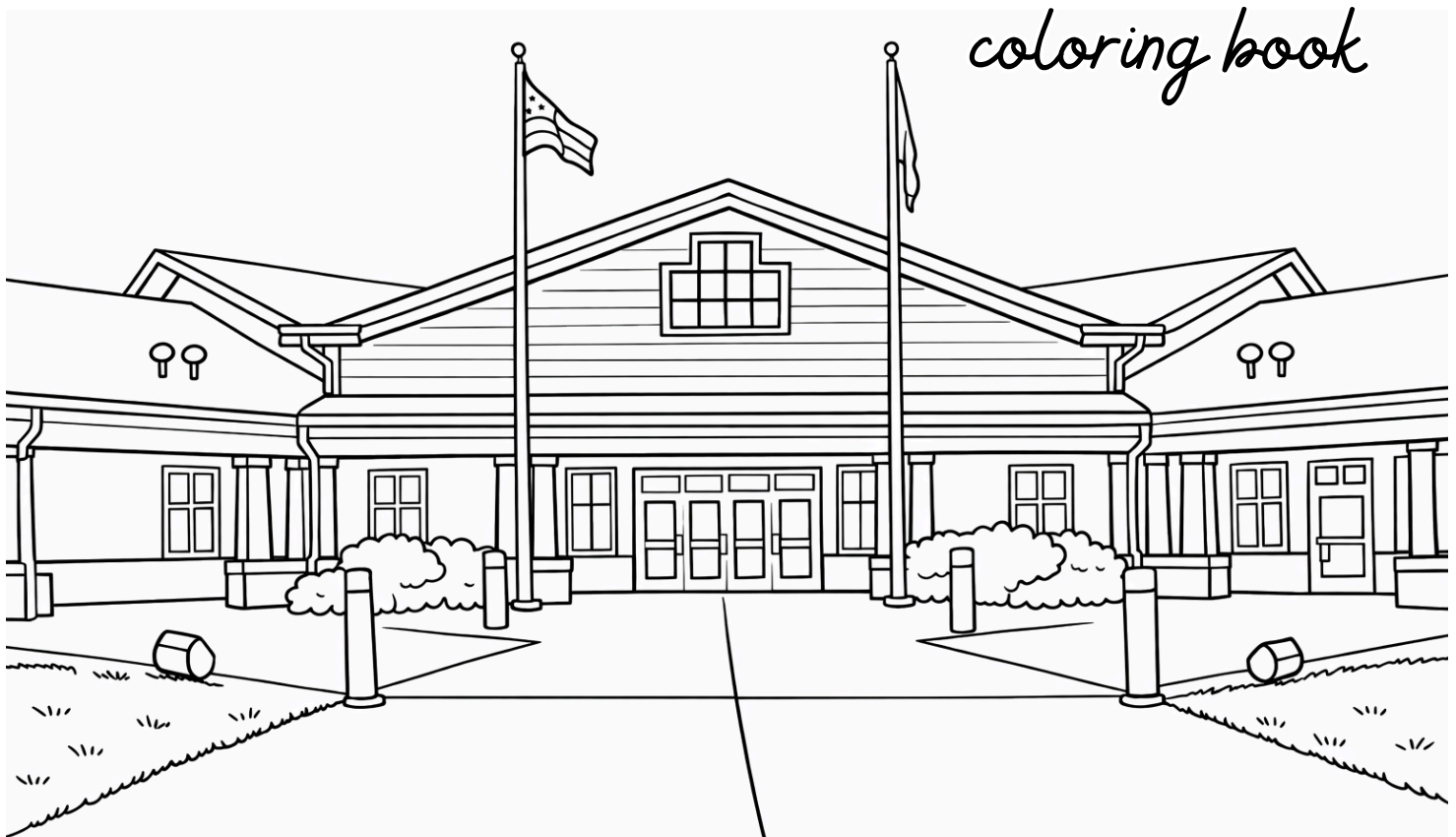

Hi, my name is Janette Walker and I am a 4-H Agent who teaches leadership and sewing to Adults and Highschool students.



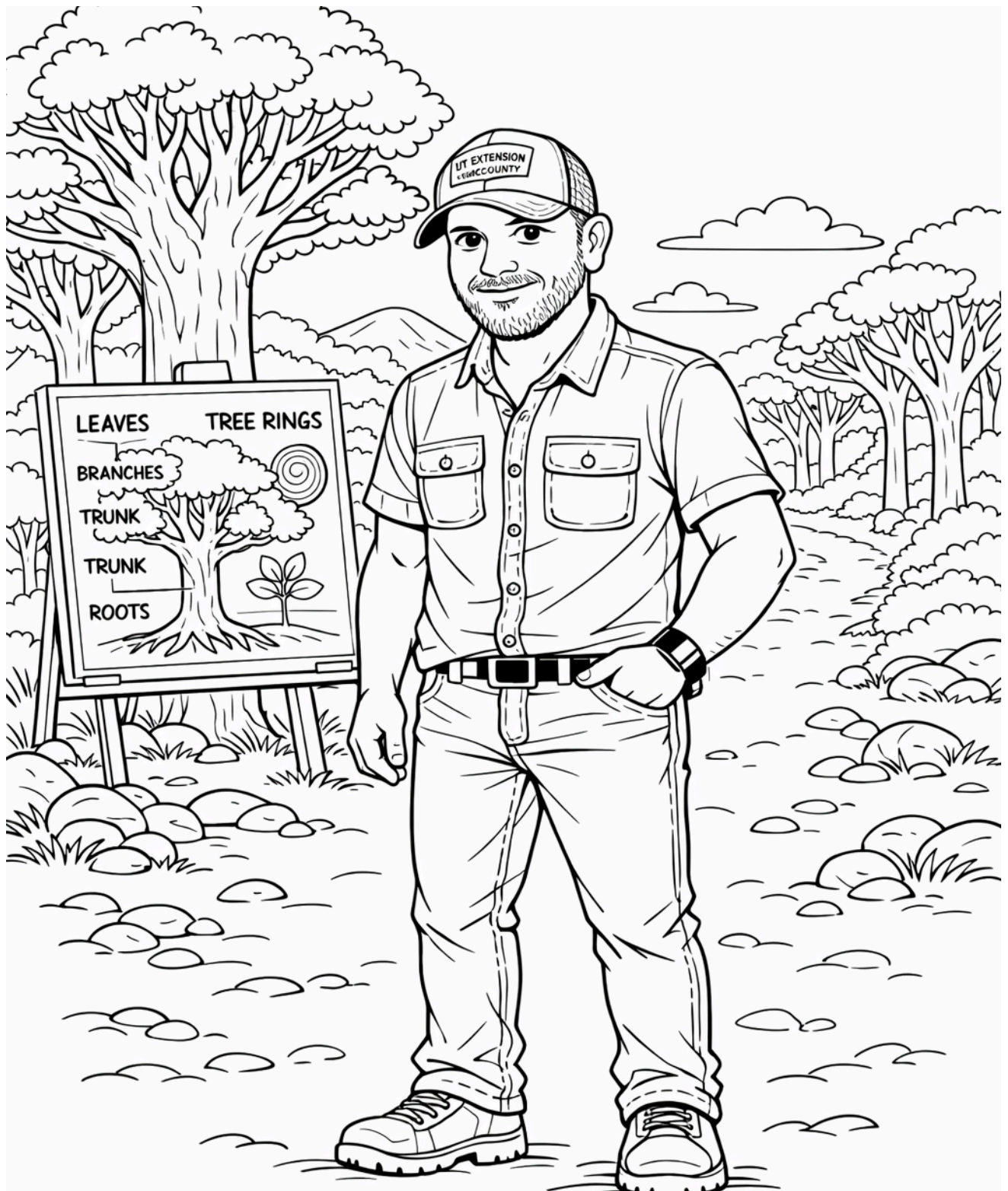
Hi, my name is Raquel Victor, I am a 4-H Agent and I teach youth sewing, cooking, cupcake decorating, and archery classes.



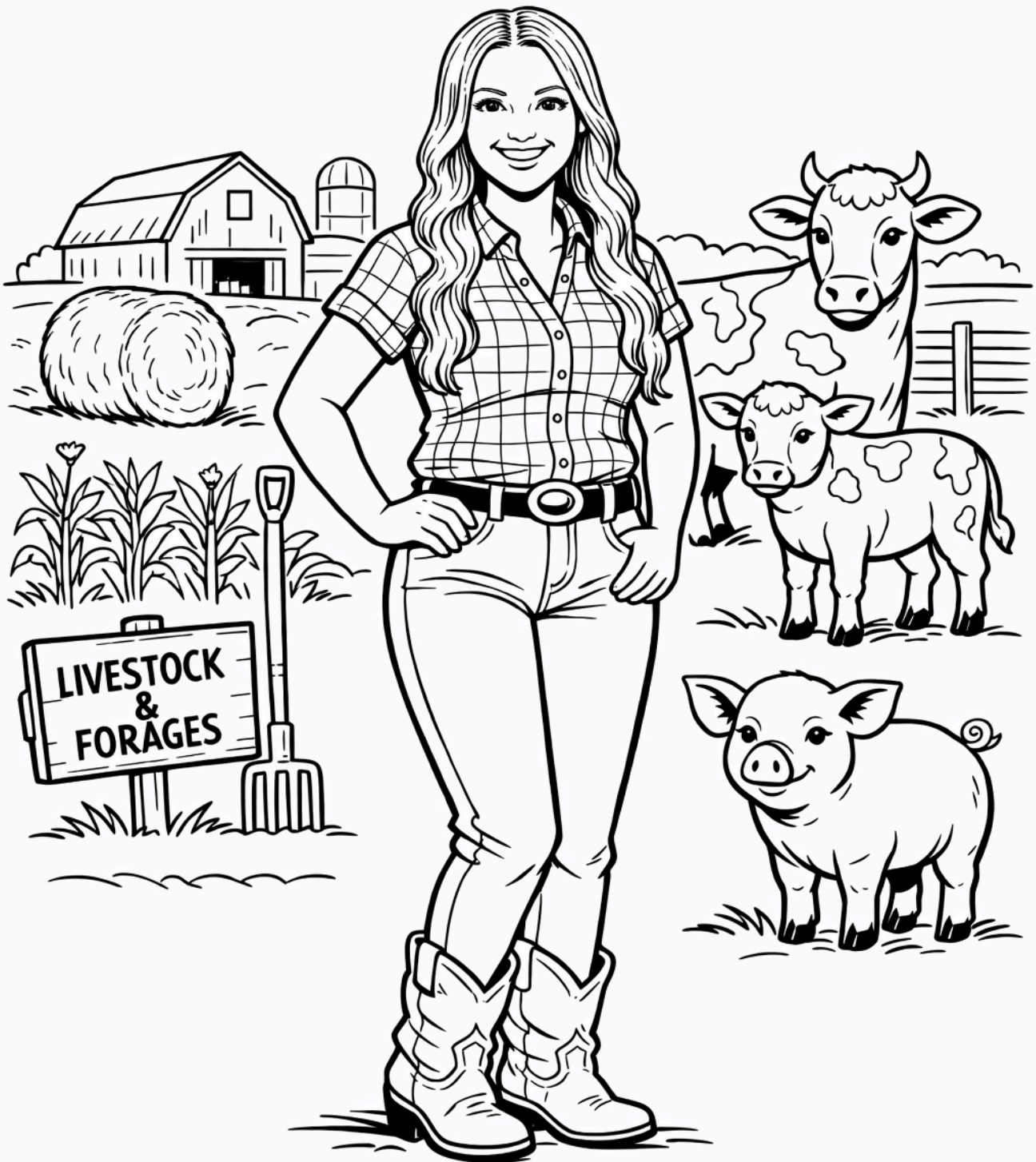
**Hi, my name is Tammy Chandler, I am a 4-H

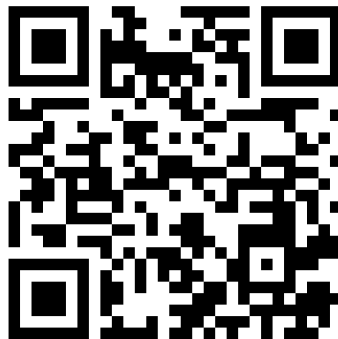
